Nomination Form

1. The Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Financial Management and Comptroller) (OASN(FM&C)) recognizes the on-base financial institutions (FI) (bank and credit union) that provided exceptional service to military and civilian personnel. This recognition is based on recommendations submitted by the Installation Commander.

2. Installation Commanders may nominate their on-base FIs by providing justification that clearly illustrates why the on-base FI should receive this honor by completing enclosure (1). Recommendations should provide specific examples of actions taken by the on-base FI during calendar year 2010 and should not exceed five pages excluding the cover memo and the current operating agreement. Any information provided over the five page limit will be excluded from review. The following criteria will be used to evaluate nominations:


- a. Service above and beyond normal requirements
- b. Special services provided at command request
- c. Financial education, participation in and support of the Military Saves campaign within Navy and Marine Corps commands, and any financial counseling services
- d. Actions taken to combat predatory lending practices
- e. Community Support
- f. Professional attitude/financial leadership
- g. Submission of a current operating agreement signed by installation commander and the FI representative
- h. Picture of the Bank or Credit Union Liaison Officer standing inside the nominated FI and in front of their prominently displayed sign of their name and duty telephone number

Subj: 2010 BANK AND CREDIT UNION RECOGNITION

Greater attention will be focused on the criteria in subparagraphs (c) and (d). These two evaluation factors are important to the Department of the Navy in maintaining the highest level of mission and financial readiness.

3. Nominations should be received in the OASN(FM&C) no later than 22 April 2011. Due to periodic delays in the mail, nominations (with a cover memorandum from the Installation Commander (or designee)) should be submitted by electronic mail whenever possible. Widest dissemination of this announcement is requested.
